

CAMPUS LIFE



This course is perfect if you wish to improve your ability to use English in everyday life. It is designed to cover the fundamental language skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking, while developing your confidence and increasing your understanding of English grammar and vocabulary. Your progress is monitored weekly with an assessment, and at the end of each 5-week term with an exam. If you have completed at least 5 weeks at that level and successfully pass your exam, you have a chance to move to the next level.


The EAP Course focuses on helping students to develop the necessary skills for academic study in mainstream courses at colleges and universities in Australia.

You will learn how to operate in a university or college culture, how to write essays and submit reports to a standard expected by a university or college in an English-speaking country, how to reference texts correctly and how to give a successful presentation.

At the end of every week, you will have conferencing (student/ teacher), to ensure that all learning objectives are met.

The IELTS test is extremely challenging, and this course is designed to help you prepare and develop techniques to ensure your success.

In order to familiarise yourself with the test, you will take regular practice tests in class. You will also have access to extra support and guidance when you need to book your external test in Australia.


